THE STUDY: Study conducted in 2021 by independent research firm, The ROI Institute. 114 Joint Commission behavioral health and human services accredited organizations provided benefit data. Respondent's length of accreditation averaged 8 years (range 2 months - 41 years). Average number of staff was 143 (range 3 - 1200). Services varied but had to include mental health services and/or substance use disorder treatment.
